



WSP Safeguarding 1 Online Zoom - FAQ's

1) How long is the workshop?

Like the face to face workshop, the online workshop is three hours and will include a number of online polls and breakout rooms to keep you engaged.

2) Is there a break?

Yes there will be 2 x 10 minute breaks during the workshop.

3) Will I still receive a certificate?

Yes. You will need to attend and engage in the whole workshop to receive your certificate. This certificate will be sent in the post to the address you gave on your eventbrite registration.

4) Are there any materials I need for the workshop?

The booklet and supporting materials will be sent to you via email before the course. You will need to have access either via laptop/printed version for the breakout room discussion. You should have a pen and paper at hand for any additional notes you want to take during discussions.

5) Do I need to attend the whole workshop?

Yes. You will need to attend and engage in the whole workshop and interact in the polls and breakout rooms in order to receive your certificate.

6) What happens if I lose my connection during the workshop?

If you have bad connection then please turn off the video but engage in discussion. If you do lose your connection during the workshop you will have five minutes to re-connect and gain access again. If you cannot connect within five minutes you will not be re-granted access into the workshop. If this happens we will accommodate you on another workshop.

7) Do I need to have a laptop in order to attend a workshop?

Yes. You will need a device with a working camera and microphone in order to attend the workshop (e.g. laptop, tablet), phones cannot be used. The camera/ video must be left on (unless discussed with the tutor) for the duration of the workshop to allow the tutor to see you are engaging in the workshop material.

8) Do I need to have a zoom account in order to attend?

Yes you will need to have a zoom account in order to participate.

9) How do I set up a zoom account?

10) How do I join the meeting?

You will be sent a text and email with registration instructions. If you are using someone else's laptop/zoom account, please change the name to your own.

11) Can two of us attend on the workshop on the same device?

No. Two people cannot attend the workshop from the one laptop, even if you are from the same household. Due to the nature of the breakout rooms and polls, each participant must attend the workshop on their own device.

12) Is it the same as attending a face to face workshop?

Yes. Due to COVID-19 Sport Ireland have developed the Safeguarding 1 Basic Awareness workshop to be delivered online. Courses will now take place via the online platform Zoom. The course is certified, it will have the same content and tutor delivering.

13) Who needs to attend a safeguarding 1 workshop?

All those working with juniors are required to complete the Safeguarding 1 workshop. A person appointed to the Club Children's Officer/ Designated Liaison Person position in a club must have attended the Safeguarding 1 workshop before attending a Safeguarding 2 (CCO) and/ or Safeguarding 3 (DLP) (ROI)/ Designated Safeguarding Children's Officer Workshop (NI).

14) Can under 18's attend?

No. You must be over 18 to attend a safeguarding workshop. If you are under 18 and require a safeguarding certificate for your National Governing Body, you should contact them directly.
