2016 Summer Camps at the Sports Hub

Multi Sport Summer Camp

We ran a four day summer camp in July at the Sports Hub for 34 children (9 to 13yrs). The camp which was organised and supervised by WSP and Northern Suburbs Community Youth Project, was funded with Dormant Accounts Funding through Sport Ireland to provide an affordable camp for children living in the Carrickphierish and Gracedieu area. The children took part in a variety of activities including cycling with Donal Jacob, hurling, camogie and football with Waterford GAA Coaching and Games Development, tennis with tennis coach Mark White along with basketball, dodgeball and football throughout the week.
