Community Groups & Services: Local Community Groups and Disability Service Providers in Waterford are invited to submit an application for funding to support them to co-ordinate a **6 Week Community Walks Programme** in their organisation for both members and the wider community, the walks are to start during the week of the **15th of January 2024.**

Closing date for receipt of applications is Wednesday 3rd January 2024 at 5pm
*Clubs will be notified of the Grant Committee's decision by Wednesday 10th January 2024 at 5pm

Who can apply? - Suitable Applicants

• Non-for-Profit Community Groups and Disability Services bases in Waterford City or County.

FUNDING GUIDELINES

- Funding awarded to successful clubs will range up to €300.
- The process for short listing will be on demonstrating your groups sustainability to co-ordinate a safe and accessible walk for club members and the wider community on a time and date set by the club.
- Healthy Ireland Community Walks must take place weekly for 6 weeks.
- Healthy Ireland Community Walks must be open to all members and the wider community.
- Healthy Ireland Community Walks must be **FREE** to participants.
- Healthy Ireland and Waterford Sports Partnership logo must be used on all advertising materials.
- Groups must indemnify Waterford Sports Partnership in respect of any legal liability, loss, claim or proceedings arising out of or in connection with death and/or bodily injury to any persons and/or loss or damage to any property which arises directly or indirectly out of the club's co-ordination of an Healthy Ireland Community Walks. Waterford Sports Partnership shall not be liable for any claims arising from the event.
- Groups with valid public liability insurance, proof to be provided if requested.
- Groups must have spent all previous WSP grants money receipts may be requested.
- Groups with policies and practices that encourage participation regardless of gender, age, race or ability.
- Where applicable, groups must have attended, or commit to attending Child Welfare and Disability Awareness training.
- Be registered or re-register with Waterford PPN (Public Participation Network) at https://www.waterfordppn.ie/registrationform/ Alternatively, email Alison de Paor, adepaor@waterfordcouncil.ie or call 058 21308.

Grant Information

- Funding can only be used for relevant promotion, equipment and refreshments that encourage participation for the walks.
- Full funding will be paid to each successful group following the completion of the first walk. Receipt will be requested.
- Each application will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.
- Where possible a WSP staff member will liaise with your group to assist with the planning and co-ordination of walks.
- The decision of the funding committee is final.

Successful Applicants

- Successful groups must comply with any reasonable request regarding publicity from WSP.
- Successful groups must capture weekly video footage & photos of their Community Walk and submit (via What's App) to WSP staff member (full details to follow). Please ensure consent is received from participants for WSP to share on social media.
- Successful clubs must keep a record of numbers attending the walks weekly
- Successful groups must complete and return the WSP Event Evaluation Form before Friday 23rd February.
